For HIS Children is a registered Canadian Christian organization dedicated to the care of orphaned and abused children around the world regardless of their race, gender or religious background. Our goal is to provide sustainable care for these children. All children deserve the right to have an education, adequate food and clothing, healthcare and a hope for tomorrow.



For HIS Children is currently involved with the King's Children Home (KCH) located in Belize, Central America. On average there are 50 children living at KCH. Many have come from very difficult circumstances. KCH offers not only shelter and the basic necessities of life, but most importantly, unconditional love and support that many of these children have never experienced. The home operates on the belief that each child should have the opportunity to live a meaningful life in a safe and compassionate environment.



Many issues the children of Belize face include:

- The majority of rural households lack adequate sanitation.
- On average, one in five children suffer from malnutrition.
- 33% of the population lives below the poverty line.
- Belize has the highest prevalence of HIV/Aids in Central America.
- A high level of crime, violence, human trafficking, and domestic violence.
- 50% of the population is under the age of 19.
- A high level of drop-outs and grade repetition. Only 25% of poor children continue on to secondary education.



KCH was founded in August 1985 by Mrs. Leonie Herrera-Gillham as a small family home. Through her work as a teacher in the rural area of the Cayo District, she came into contact with children who had been abandoned or neglected by their parents and families with various difficulties who were unable to care for their children. KCH provides protection of the welfare of every child in the home.

KCH believes that each child has the right to an adequate standard of living, to healthcare, to education and to be treated without discrimination. KCH maintains a family setting where children develop emotionally sound and secure in a loving Christian environment.
